This is a fast paced, hands on position, working in a team environment. Responsible for the assembly of products using established production procedures, following safety protocol, and adhering to company's quality standards, policies, and procedures.

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Read work orders or other instructions to determine product specifications or materials requirements.
- Cut and assemble materials using various fabrication techniques according to instructions.
- Evaluate quality of materials. Identify problems or imperfections in products.
- Pack products and prepare them for shipment.
- Maintain good housekeeping and clean work areas in assigned space.
- Unload and organize and stock materials.
- Minimum 32 hours per week. May work overtime when it is available.
- Accountable for the production tasks they interact with directly.
- Develop skills and increase value of work contributions by cross training in multiple production departments over time.
- Other duties as assigned.

REQUIRED SKILLS/ABILITIES:

- Use different types of hand tools (scissors, razors, glue gun, pliers, etc.), power tools (jigs and dies) and equipment.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Ability to stand 8-10 hours per shift. This position primarily works in a manufacturing environment with a cement floor.

- Visual acuity to determine the accuracy, neatness and thoroughness of the work assigned. Good hand and eye coordination.
- Stooping, kneeling, reaching, standing, walking, pushing, pulling lifting, grasping, repetitive motion.
- Ability to lift 35 - 50 lbs.
